

Edgerton Pottery and Art Festival

Art Vendor Terms & Conditions

- Art vendors at the Edgerton Clay Day & Pottery Festival must be 18 years of age or older. An exception will be made for students of the Edgerton High School Art Department, as a group.
- The festival is held rain or shine.
- Vendors must remain open for the entirety of the festival hours.
- Entry fee is nonrefundable once your application has been approved.
- All booth spaces are 10' x 10'. One booth per entry. Shared booths are discouraged, however if two or more artists from the same studio or guild wish to share a booth, photos must be submitted by all participating artists and will be juried as a whole.
- All exhibited work must be original in concept and must have been created by the accepted applicant.
- Each exhibitor's work may be screened by jurors during the festival. Artists whose work does not comply with the rules, or differs from the images submitted, will be asked to leave. The judgement of the jury will be final, and no refunds will be given.
- Artists must be present to exhibit and manage their displays during the festival. Artists are limited to the booth space(s) they were assigned; booth spaces are non-transferable. Any artist who has not been accepted into the festival will not be allowed to exhibit.
- All sales will be conducted between the artist and the purchaser.
 Participating artists must show proof of a State of Wisconsin Seller's Permit prior to the festival and must collect and pay Wisconsin sales tax on all sales made during the festival. Accepted artists will not be permitted to exhibit until this permit number has been recorded.
- Artists responsible for damages to City grounds will be held liable.
- General liability is required for each vendor. Neither our insurance nor your signature on the application waiver covers what goes on within your selling space. This is covered by your insurance only.
